### **B.SC. (HONOURS COURSE): SEMESTER – V TO SEMESTER –VI**

A student offering Honours Course in Semester – V and Semester – VI has to choose any one of the elective subjects offered in semester I to Semester – IV provided that the students offering the subject as Honours Course shown in column (A) has passed the subjects shown in column (B) in the 10+2 (Science) or Equivalent examination recognised by the Manipur University.

A students offering General Course will continue to offer the same three elective subjects offered in previous semesters (Semester – I to Semester – IV) in Semester – V and Semester – VI.

### **B.A. (HONOURS AND GENERAL): SEMESTER – I TO SEMESTER – IV**

Each semester of the first 2 (two) years i.e. Semester – I, Semester – II, Semester – III and Semester – IV for both Honours and General Courses shall have four papers:

1 (one) paper on foundation course: MIL (MAN)/ General English (GEN) in Semester I and Semester – II, Regional Development (RD) in Semester – III and Environmental Studies (EVS) in Semester – IV
